Awards Presentation Ceremony marks a successful end for The 14th Hong Kong - Asia Film Financing Forum

Recognition of outstanding film projects in Asia

Hong Kong, 16 March, 2016 – The finest filmmakers from across Asia are celebrating today after winning awards at the 14th Hong Kong - Asia Film Financing Forum (HAF). 14 awards, which are given to film projects showing the greatest amount of potential, were handed out at a presentation ceremony which marked the end of this year's HAF. The forum, which was held at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre, ran for three days and is one of the highlights of the Asian film calendar.

The HAF award winners were selected from 31 film projects from 15 countries and regions, including China, Denmark, Georgia, Hong Kong, India, Japan, Kazakhstan, Malaysia, Norway, Philippines, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Thailand and Vietnam. This year, HAF received more than 350 submissions, a record-breaking number. This year's projects covered a wide range of topics and feature a mix of renowned filmmakers as well as new, up and coming talent. The total prize money across all awards amounted to approximately HK\$1,478,500 (US\$190,800) in cash and value in-kind.

Mr. Wellington FUNG, Assistant Head of Create Hong Kong kicked off the ceremony by presenting **HAF Awards**. *Vampire Dairy* (Hong Kong) and *The Third Wife* (Vietnam) won the categories of Hong Kong Project and Non-Hong Kong Project respectively. Presented by Create Hong Kong, Hong Kong Film Development Fund and HAF, each project won a cash prize of HK\$150,000 (approx.US\$19,300). The winners were selected by the Project Reading Committee and were praised for their originality and creativity.

Presented by this year's premium sponsor iQIYI, the **iQIYI's Special Award** went to *Dying to Survive* (China), winning a cash award of HK\$100,000 (approx. US\$12,900). The award recognises promising young film talent from Chinese-speaking territories.

Brothers (Malaysia) won the **HAF/Fox Chinese Film Development Award**. Presented by 20th Century Fox International Productions (Greater China) (Fox), the award aims to encourage the development of Chinese-language cinema. The project received HK\$100,000 (approx. US\$12,900) and a development contract with Fox.

The **HAF Script Development Fund**, presented by Star Chinese Movies and the Hong Kong International Film Festival Society Limited, went to *Heavy Craving* (Taiwan). As an initiative driven by Ms. Sylvia CHANG, the former Vice Chairman of the Hong Kong International Film Festival Society Limited, this award aims to encourage quality Chinese-language scripts. The movie channel Star Chinese Movies is supporting the Script Development Fund award for the second year. A cash award of US\$10,000 (approx. HK\$77,500) was presented to the winner.

This year's **Wouter Barendrecht Award**, presented by Wouter Barendrecht Film Foundation, Create Hong Kong and Hong Kong Film Development Fund, went to *Inking a Last Masterpiece* (Japan). Dedicated to the memory of the late Wouter Barendrecht, the renowned film producer and one of the founders of HAF, this award of HK\$50,000 (approx. US\$6,450) recognises projects by a director under the age of 35 who has not made more than three feature films.





The **Fushan Documentary Award** went to *Border Bride* (Hong Kong and China), receiving a cash prize of HK\$100,000 (approx. US\$12,900) and a development contract with Fushan Features.

This year new partners have joined HAF to present awards. The **Wanda Film Award** presented by Wanda Media Co. Ltd. celebrates a creative and original Chinese-language feature film project. The cash award of HK\$100,000 (approx. US\$12,900) and a development contract with Wanda was awarded to *Lieutenant Yi* (Taiwan).

Another new award for this year's HAF is the **Artention Film Award** which was given to *Dying to Survive* (China). The award aims to encourage film projects that exhibit high artistic and commercial potential. *Dying to Survive* received HK\$50,000 (approx. US\$6,450) and priority entry into the Artention Film Incubator, based at Artention's International Visual Arts and Film Center in Shenzhen. With its extensive partnership in Hollywood and state-of-the-art facilities, Artention will support the winning project in its development.

Another new award for HAF 2016 is the **Wutianming Post Production Award** that aims to support young talent working on Chinese film projects. The award went to *Lhamo And Skalbe* (China), winning post-production services at the National Animation Industry Park in Tianjin that values RMB300,000 (approx. HK\$350,400).

Several valued partners returned to give awards at HAF this year.

When the Waves are Gone (Philippines) won the **Paris Coproduction Village Award**. The project will be invited to participate in the Paris Coproduction Village at the Champs-Elysèes Film Festival 2016. One round-trip plane ticket will be offered to a representative of the project.

The **Network of Asian Fantastic Films Award**, presented by Bucheon International Fantastic Film Festival, went to *Hypnotize the Jury* (Hong Kong). The winning project was awarded a round-trip plane ticket and accommodation to participate in the 2016 Network of Asian Fantastic Films project market, which will take place during Bucheon International Fantastic Film Festival in July in South Korea.

This year's **White Light Post-Production Award**, designed to promote cinematic innovation and promising Asian directors, went to *The Third Wife* (Vietnam). The winner received post-production services by White Light Studio in Bangkok, Thailand worth US\$15,000 (approx. HK\$116,200).

The final award was presented by G2D from Thailand. **G2D Post Production Award** went to *Border Bride* (Hong Kong and China). The film project won post-production services, including laboratory services, digital imaging and sound services, which is worth US\$10,000 (approx.HK\$77,500).

Mr. Jacob WONG, Curator of the Hong Kong International Film Festival Society and HAF Director, said, "The award panels had many tough decisions to make. Thanks to the high quality of the entries across the board, the projects come from across Asia and cover many different genres but what links them all together is their quality."

Mr. Roger GARCIA, Executive Director of the Hong Kong International Film Festival Society, praised the excellence and diversity of all shortlisted film projects. "I would like to congratulate the winners and would also like to pay tribute to all the filmmakers in Asia who submitted films – the breadth and depth of the industry is outstanding. We are also very grateful to the continued support of Create Hong Kong and the Hong Kong Film Development Fund that are dedicated to supporting both local production and Hong Kong's position as a regional film hub. We thank our





partners – both returning and new – who have shown their confidence in the value and appeal of HAF and its selection of projects." $\,$
