ONE-SENTENCE SYNOPSIS

A series of complicated stories happen within two days among seventeen members of the same family.

SYNOPSIS

Liu Tairan is going to celebrate his 90th birthday. He is alone at home. Recently, Liu has suffered from cerebral thrombosis and almost has lost his ability to care for himself. As Liu's 90th birthday approaches, his six children decide to come home to celebrate the birthday and discuss how to take care of the old man. All his children are living in the town. They have close relations and rely on each other. Yet, they all have their own family problems and persuasive reasons not to take care of Liu in their own house. Therefore, at the birthday party, the accumulated problems among the family members keep bubbling up. The big family is facing a storm.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

The film wants to recreate traditions of 1930s and 1940s Chinese films, using a typical Chinese family as the main point to reflect about current Chinese society. A family constitutes a typical "Chinese network".

The film is going to use the ensemble cast to tell the stories of this family. It will take a deep look at the Chinese family and Chinese society through the viewpoints of these 17 protagonists of three different generations. The film wants to talk about freedom through the relationships between individuals and family. What makes us lose our freedom? Is it family? Work? Tradition? Responsibility? Morality? Or is it the growing fear that swallows our minds?

Yan Xiaolin graduated from Nanjing University of Finance and Economics, and worked as producer of different TV shows. Yan has done approximately 10 short films. In 2015, Yan finished his first feature film with extreme low budget - *The Years I Watch Hong Kong Movies*.

Yang Cheng (born in 1985) graduated from Beijing Film Academy with a MFA in Literature. Yang worked as the President of Heaven Pictures, the Vice President of Laurel Films and founded Nezha Bros. Pictures in 2016. Yang has produced or co-produced *Fly with the Crane* (2012, (Horizons, Venice Film Festival); *River Road* (2014, Competition, Tokyo International Film Festival); *My Original Dream* (2015, Competition, Tokyo International Film Festival); *Have a Nice Day* (2017, Competition, Berlin Film Festival) and *Ghost in the Mountain* (2017, Panorama, Berlin Film Festival).
