#### **ONE-SENTENCE SYNOPSIS**

Fear does not come from death, it comes from sex.

#### **SYNOPSIS**

Alan, a sick man, has little time left in his life. His friends try to give him happiness as much as they can. Ken's girlfriend Chamba even hires a part-time girlfriend, Beth, for him, so he can have his first sexual encounter. However, Beth stands him up that night. Chamba has no alternative but to make love to Alan in her place. When the incident eventually comes out, Ken experiences neither anger nor blame, but is forced to grapple with the fragmented memories of what he has done before.

#### **DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT**

This film is about teenagers. They have their own forms of dealing with problems, which can both be normal and abnormal, such as sex. Alan is the repressed one whereas Ken is the outgoing one. What will they do when sex comes between their friendship?

Another theme is death. When death comes close, we can finally realise the time that we wasted the day before. Yet, we still cannot get to know what we should chase next or if there is still anything that is worth pursuing. Teenagers always feel lost in this world, but what is more important for me is the absurdity underlying teenagers' perspectives.
