## **ONE-SENTENCE SYNOPSIS**

# **SYNOPSIS**

After her college graduation, Yezi comes back home to spend her last summer vacation with her grandmother, who has been living alone ever since grandfather passed away. The house is filled with grandma's memories that gradually begin to take on actual forms in life. Sometimes they appear as a cat, a plant or a total stranger, while at other times, they manifest themselves as grandpa or even Yezi's childhood self. At the same time, grandma slowly slips into the abyss of amnesia and time begins to lose meaning. Haunted by those tireless memories, Yezi finds herself wandering among fragments of her family history, where she recollects a deserted childhood and befriends her own past. One night, everyone gathers by a fish pond for a grand farewell. When it seems to be another one of grandma's dream, all the loved ones decide to stay.

#### **DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT**

I am captivated by the emotions that bind people closely. Even if those with deep bonds do not always stay together till the end, there will forever be some forms of interaction in between. I believe deceased family members come back in my dreams so as to be with me in whichever ways possible. In that light, *Virgin Blue* is not about how to face the loss of our loved ones, but rather about how to be together with them. We cannot stop losing those we love. Life is a continuous process of facing defeats and failures. That is why we should choose to be with them. This film offers many ways to do so.
