ONE-SENTENCE SYNOPSIS

She is Chinese; he is Mexican: two immigrants living on the fringes of American society in search of the truth about a shared UFO abduction.

SYNOPSIS

Mysterious Solomon lives and works in a recycling plant in New York City. A self-taught science wiz, he has made his own radio telescope from spare parts to search for extraterrestrial communications. He believes that his mother, who went missing years ago when crossing the border in the Arizona desert, was abducted by a UFO. By chance he meets the alluring Chuyao, a manicurist who unwillingly moonlights in dangerous fetish games. A violent confrontation with Chuyao's criminal boyfriend leaves these two illegal aliens heading West, on the run from the law while hunting down a shared UFO experience.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

We Are Living Things is set in the United States but its main characters are illegal aliens. In the story, Solomon (Mexican) and Chuyao (Chinese) meet by chance, but as the events unfold the characters begin to sense that they "know each other from somewhere else". They both have had powerful experiences that seem to indicate hidden dimensions beyond everyday reality, yet they do not know what to make of these experiences or how to share them. Solomon and Chuyao are strong-willed and have had to overcome hardships for most of their lives. In order to survive and to see a light at the end of the tunnel, they are both believers. But what they believe in is not institutionalised religion: it is the existence of an external, out-of-space life form that could save them. Our story is an "out of time" ironic fable with a science-fiction element that acts as a metaphor, yet we believe our film also captures something very immediate about the world we are living in right now, the "funhouse mirror" reality we have come to know. It also resonates with current national and global controversies over migration, protectionism, and border patrols.

Antonio Tibaldi is an Italian film director living in New York. Tibaldi's fiction and non-fiction feature films have won numerous awards, playing at Berlin, Sundance, San Sebastian, Rotterdam, IDFA and Tribeca. They have been released by Miramax, Warner Bros., and Lionsgate. As a consultant for UNTV (United Nations Television) he has shed light on under-reported realities in South and Central America, Africa, and Asia. Tibaldi studied at CalArts, where he received an MFA in Film & Video. His projects have received support from IFP, TFI (Tribeca Film Institute), Film Independent, WEMW (When East Meets West), Biografilm, and Dok.Incubator.
