The 23rd Hong Kong - Asia Film Financing Forum (HAF) Brief Report

The 23rd Hong Kong - Asia Film Financing Forum (HAF) was held as a physical, in-person event supplementary with online meetings from 17 - 19 March 2025 at the Hong Kong Convention & Exhibition Centre in conjunction with the 29th Hong Kong Film & TV Market (FILMART).

The forum was organised by the **Hong Kong International Film Festival Society** (HKIFFS), coorganised by the **Hong Kong Trade Development Council** (HKTDC), and financially supported by **Cultural and Creative Industries Development Agency** (CCIDA) and **Film Development Fund** (FDF). Held concurrently with **Hong Kong International Film and TV Market** (FILMART) for the eighteenth time, HAF was once again one of the core events of Entertainment Expo Hong Kong.

HAF is widely recognised as one of the most significant film-financing platforms in Asia. Over the three-day period, HAF attracted leading film financers, producers, distributors and buyers, connecting them with talented filmmakers through business meetings and seminar, pitching and networking events for potential co-production opportunities.

1. Shortlisted Projects

This year, HAF received 276 submissions in the In-Development Project (IDP) section and 122 submissions in the Work-in-Progress Project (WIP) section. 25 IDPs and 15 WIPs were selected.

To further diversify its support for emerging talents, HAF has introduced a dedicated Animation Projects section, spotlighting animated feature films in both development and post-production stages. A total of 6 projects were selected for its first edition.

This year marked the 9th edition of "Work-in-Progress" Open Pitch, a programme aims to promote the selected film projects and connect the talented filmmakers with professionals and investors, post-production companies, distribution agents and film festival programmers. The target audiences are the film industry professionals attending FILMART and HAF. Filmmakers from the shortlisted work-in-progress projects were invited to present their projects on stage at the Starlight Theatre on March 17 and 18, 2025. The event saw participation from 802 guests representing various countries. Private meetings were arranged with attendees to explore potential collaborations.

A total of 18 shortlisted work-in-progress projects are being presented, primarily from Hong Kong and other Asian countries or regions. These include 15 feature fiction film projects and 3 animation projects, launched under this year's newly established animation initiative. Among them are 12 feature debuts, 6 non-Chinese language projects, and 8 international coproductions.
