# The 12<sup>th</sup> Hong Kong - Asia Film Financing Forum Successfully Completed and Announced Seven Awards

**26 March 2014, Wednesday** – Officiated by **Mr Jerry LIU**, Head of Create Hong Kong, the 12<sup>th</sup> Hong Kong - Asia Film Financing Forum came to the end today with the 12<sup>th</sup> HAF Awards Presentation Ceremony, held at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre. A total of seven awards from six categories were presented to participating filmmakers, including: **HAF Awards**, **HAF/Fox Film Development Award**, **HAF Script Development Fund**, **Fushan Documentary Award**, **Wouter Barendrecht Award**, and **Network of Asian Fantastic Films Award**.

The HAF awards winners were selected from 29 film projects from 11 countries and regions across Asia, including Afghanistan, Bhutan, China, Hong Kong, India, Japan, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Taiwan and Thailand.

Commenting on this year's forum, Mr Jerry LIU said, "For the 12<sup>th</sup> consecutive year, we gather here to connect with and celebrate some of the most talented filmmakers and their projects from around Asia. And once again, we continue to see the vibrant and diversified Asia film industry and its great potential for promising growth through the eventful three days."

The 12<sup>th</sup> HAF remains as one of the most important film financing platforms in Asia while expanding its impact and leverage its influence on more film genres. Adding to existing film awards is the brand new **Fushan Documentary Award**, which was established in partnership with and supported by Fushan Features. All documentaries selected by the HAF were automatically nominated for this award, and in the end, film project *Dust* from China was crowned the winner. The film project is directed by **ZHAO Liang**, and produced by **PANG Yee-wah** and **Sylvie BLUM**.

Presented by Create Hong Kong, Hong Kong Film Development Fund and the Hong Kong - Asia Film Financing Forum, HAF Awards (Hong Kong Project) and (non-Hong Kong Project) went to film projects Angel Whispers from Hong Kong and Private Eyes from Taiwan respectively. Angel Whispers is directed by Carrie NG and Shirley YUNG and produced by Carrie NG, Shirley YUNG and CHAN Pang-chun. Private Eyes is directed by CHANG Jung-Chi and produced by CHEN Hung-Yuan and PANG Yee-wah. Each of the winning projects was granted with a cash award of HK\$150,000 for their originality and creativity.

2014 marks the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of the **HAF/Fox Chinese Film Development Award**, which was established in partnership with Fox International Productions (Greater China). The award, which aims to nurture script development, has become a platform for talented writers and directors to pursue their career in the film industry. Film project *Love is Speaking* from China, directed by **SHU Haolun** and produced by **LE Bei**, was crowned this year's winner of the HK\$100,000 cash award, and received a Development Contract with Fox.

Presented by Emperor Motion Pictures and the Hong Kong International Film Festival Society, the **HAF Script Development Fund** entered into its 4<sup>th</sup> anniversary as an initiative driven by Ms. Sylvia CHANG, the former Vice Chairman of The Hong Kong International Film Festival Society Limited, to encourage quality Chinese-language scripts. Selected by the reading committee, film project *The Solitary Pier* from Taiwan was honoured the winner. The project is directed by **Jack SHIH** and produced by **DAI Hsin-Ping**.





This year's **Wouter Barendrecht Award**, presented by Wouter Barendrecht Film Foundation, Create Hong Kong, and Hong Kong Film Development Fund, went to *Hip Hop Kabul* from Afghanistan, directed by **Fazila AMIRI** and produced by **Paul LEE**. The award is established to reward a project with a director under the age of 35 and has not made more than three feature films.

The winner list rounded off with **Network of Asian Fantastic Film Award**, which went to *Dead, End* from India. The film project is directed by **Dev BENEGAL** and produced by **Dev BENEGAL** and **Satish KAUSHIK**. The winner of this award will be invited to participate in the Network of Asian Fantastic Films 2014 with travel package as an in-kind award.

Dr. Wilfred Wong, Chairman of the Hong Kong International Film Festival Society, praised the high quality and diversity of all 29 selected film projects and recognized the 12<sup>th</sup> HAF as a productive and fruitful event, "I would like to thank all filmmakers, financiers, festival delegates, sales agents and distributors for their participation that continues to make HAF a success and helps to further strengthen Hong Kong's position as a cinema hub in the region. My gratitude also goes to all our partners, advisors, and reading committee members who provide HAF filmmakers an opportunity to make their projects come to life."
