ONE-SENTENCE SYNOPSIS

Torn between her identities as a disreputable prostitute and a virtuous mother, Ruan Yumei (called as "Auntie Yuen") believes education can save her daughter Shurui. Yet, who is responsible for her daughter's unexpected death?

SYNOPSIS

Shurui's corpse flows on the river soullessly.

Her name is Zhang Shurui. Her mother, Ruan Yumei, is a prostitute in a one-woman brothel in Sham Shui Po. She believes education is her daughter's best chance to a brighter future. Therefore, she had high hopes for her daughter's DSE results. Unfortunately, her artistic talent was not enough for the rigid education system.

Xuan Zhihe is the English teacher in a secondary public school. One day, Shurui missed Zhihe's home visit and Zhihe discovered that he had a sexual exchange with Shurui's mother before. Yumei took the opportunity to threat and seduce him. After that, Yumei pleaded for his help with Shurui's education. Since then, Zhihe has become disoriented, lost in lust for a youthful body of Shurui. Zhihe and Shurui develop the love between teachers and students.

The tension between Yumei and Shurui lessens as her grades improved. As Yumei begins to imagine building a family with Zhihe, Shurui discovers her mother's affair with Zhihe. Shurui feels betrayed by both of them. For vengeance, Shurui seduces Zhihe, losing her virginity to him.

Meanwhile, Yumei dedicates her time to participating in a classic play, *The Goddess*, in Zi Teng, in a sex workers society therapy session. Acting the role of a prostitute in 30's Shanghai, she finds the character, Ruan Lingyu, similar to herself and hopes light will shine through the darkness of her life.

Yumei, however, becomes furious and heartbroken when she finds out Shurui was impregnated by Zhihe. After that, Shurui goes missing. For vengeance, Yumei acts like she contacted Zhihe for help to find Shurui; however, she has already planned to kill Zhihe in the dark. One can only become truly learned in the lessons of life by seeing the end of one's own life.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

The Goddess pays homage to the classic 1930's Chinese film, The Goddess. The remake takes place in modern Hong Kong, focused on the issues of the Hong Kong public education system, the life of Mainlander immigrants, conflicts between mother and daughter, and power struggles between men and women. We are going to reinterpret the meaning and complex humanity of the classic story of *The Goddess* in contemporary society. Director Chan uses Chinese aesthetic and artistic essences to convey a cautionary tale of pursuing light in the darkness of society.
