

ONE-SENTENCE SYNOPSIS

Singer Lin Wan returned to Xinshi for a concert, reminding her driver, Kang, of the mysteriously disappeared painter Lu Qi. Through Lu's painting, he discovers their endless waiting.

SYNOPSIS

In 2006, singer Lin Wan returned to Xinshi, a small town in northern China, to hold a concert. A rumor has surfaced that she came back to find the ghost of Lu Qi, a disappeared painter. It reminded her driver, Kang, of an unsolved mystery that happened at a party at the villa of his boss, Ma Yuan, deep in the mountains. A few years earlier, Lu Qi had come to paint a portrait of Ma Yuan. When the portrait was unveiled at the party, the chandelier in the villa fell and Lu Qi suddenly disappeared into thin air. Kang was ordered to search for Lu Qi, and he met a woman, Kong, who was then travelling around the world. Attracted by Kong's voice, Kang went to a southern town by himself to attend a wedding, lost in the Century Park full of puzzles.

Through the only landscape painting of Lu Qi, Kang discovered a buried secret related to Chinese geography and Lu Qi's endless waiting. He thus started to draw the outline of love and friendship of Lin Wan, Ma Yuan and Lu Qi.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

This is a story about a meeting gone awry. People often think what is missed is missed forever, but I saw the possibility of rejoining the missed connection, to remedy the wound in space. I understood that film can do this when I shot my first feature, *Vanishing Days*. The modern reformation of the city has destroyed my personal way of remembering space. Landmarks had disappeared, and I could not find my way. This feels like having an appointment, but being unable to find the way to the destination. I was anxious and fretful, like the lovers in this story.

M. C. Escher's paintings are characterized by mysterious contradictions, showing perfectly disjointed parts in a very romantic way. Some of his paintings remind me of what I saw in Northwestern China, where surprisingly, my memories of South flooded into my mind. So, I want to make a film in which Southern and Northern China are intertwined, linked by a great waterfall want to reconnect the memories and illusion, just as in Escher's landscape paintings. There are many travel-worn and miserable people in past Chinese films; however, I often think there must be something light and sweet that they commonly share.
