SYNOPSIS

Xiao Lu is an avid traveller in her early thirties who spends much of her time overseas. After learning that she has metastatic breast cancer, she decides to invite her parents on a journey, which might be her last one. The family reunites for only four days; along with trivialities between

tears and laughter, they do not really get along well. Yet, they become closer to each other. When the family trip comes to an end, Xiao Lu's father suddenly dies of a heart attack. Her mother becomes the only person she will say goodbye to.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

I am the "black sheep" in my family, often taking a backpack and toothbrush on the road, leave without saying goodbye. When my own physical problems emerged, the relationship with my family began to change. By writing the play, I was privileged to observe my family, including myself, from every angle. In *Happy Journey and Last Will*, it is death that binds a family together, but in the end we could leave with love. Farewell always comes unexpectedly; yet we try to record a traveler's perception of life through film.
